

CENTURY BOULEVARD — EXTENSION — • E MAIN TO LOIS •



Project scope:

- Build a three-lane road between E Main and SE Lois streets with:
 - A new segment of roadway between E Main and SW Borwick streets with a bridge over Rock Creek.
 - Realignment of the road between SE Ariel and SE Lois streets.
 - Bicycle and pedestrian facilities.
 - Street lighting.
 - A new signalized intersection at SE Lois Street and SE Century Boulevard.

Schedule:

- Final design is expected to be completed in late 2020.
- Construction is expected to start in spring 2021.
- Construction is expected to take about 18 months to complete.
- Project schedules are estimates and subject to change.

Environmental impacts:

- Wetland information has been submitted to Department of State Lands for review. Little or no impact is anticipated.
- Coordinating with Hillsboro Parks & Recreation to determine:
 - Impacts to the Noble Woods Park entrance.
 - Mitigation for trees to be removed: An estimated 47 trees will be impacted. The project goal is to plant at least 47 new trees.
