Washington County invites you to attend an open house to learn more about improvements planned for the Walker Road and Murray Boulevard intersection.

The project team will be available to answer questions and solicit comments from the public. No formal presentation is planned.

PROJECT DESCRIPTIONS

Improvements to the Walker Road and Murray Boulevard intersection include dual left turn lanes and dedicated right turn lanes at all four approaches. A third southbound through-lane will also be added to Murray Boulevard from south of Butner Road through the intersection. This additional through lane will become a dedicated right turn lane at Bowman Drive.

Additional improvements include replacing two bridges over Cedar Mill Creek that are adjacent to the intersection. One bridge is located on Murray Boulevard, south of Walker Road and the second bridge is located on Walker Road, east of Murray Boulevard. Two culverts located on Walker Road between Far Vista Street and Park Way will also be replaced as part of this project.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

This project is currently in the preliminary design phase. Construction is estimated for 2018; however, this date is tentative and subject to change.
